We invite you to join us for the fifth biennial revival E-M-F Company Outing. This is a five day pre-1916 hub tour for E-M-F and related marques. For 2012 we will be headquartered in Lancaster, PA. This is a beautiful area in which to tour with old cars. There is much to see and do. Please consider joining us even if you cannot bring a car. This is a friendly group and rides are available.

The room rate is \$139 plus tax per night double occupancy including a private hot breakfast buffet in our meeting room each tour day and Saturday for those choosing to stay Friday night.

Make your reservations under the "E-M-F Company Outing" group. There is a limited room block, so reserve your room early. The rate may not be available after the June 22, 2012 hotel cut-off date.

Camping is available at the Old Millstream Campground just 3 miles from the hotel. Several sites with full hook-up have been reserved under the "E-M-F Company Outing" group with Gil Fitzhugh named as "wagon master". Reserve your space early since availability is limited. Trailer parking will be at the hotel on pavement or stone. There are several outer lots away from the building that have sufficient space for us. These lots are covered by the hotel's normal security process. No camping at trailer parking.

We have a full week planned for you starting with tour check-in from 1:00 PM Sunday followed by a Dessert Social on Sunday evening at 7:30 PM. There will also be a short "early bird" tour available Sunday afternoon for those who can't wait until Monday to go for a ride. Tours will range from 40 to 120 miles each day. Several tours are suitable for the smaller cars, so if you have a two cylinder Northern, bring it along.

Directions to the Courtyard by Marriott Lancaster: From the West, take the PA Turnpike to Route 283 at Harrisburg toward Lancaster to Route 30 East. From the East, take the PA Turnpike to Route 222 South at Reading toward Lancaster to Route 30 East. From Lancaster on Route 30 East, take the Greenfield Road Exit then Keep Right onto Greenfield Road. Turn Right at Light onto Hempstead Road. The hotel entrance is on the left after Olde Homestead Lane. For GPS navigation, use 1805 Olde Homestead Lane, Lancaster, PA 17601.

Directions to Camping: Follow the above directions to Route 30 East. Continue past the Greenfield Road Exit. Divided highway ends. Continue through several traffic lights. Driveway to the Old Millstream Campground is just beyond Dutch Wonderland amusement park on left.

Directions from Camping to the Courtyard by Marriott Lancaster: Right out of campground onto Route 30 West. First Right at Light onto Harvest Road. Left at Stop onto Hobson Road. Right at Stop onto Oakview Road. Left at Light onto Old Philadelphia Pike Route 340 West. Immediate Right at Light onto Horseshoe Road. First Left onto Jefferson Road. Left at T-Stop onto William Penn Way, becomes Hempstead Road. Hotel on right after Colonial Village Lane.
