- Tour to see a working marine railway on the world famous Trent Severn Waterway. Lunch will be provided.

Friday, August 12th

- Tour to Gravenhurst for a luncheon cruise aboard SS Segwun.

- Visit to a boat museum where you see some fabulous, antique wooden boats, for which Muskoka is renowned.

Saturday, August 13th

- Our cars will be featured in a special display at the huge Downtown Orillia Car Show. Other early vehicles will be joining us to help highlight the “real” antique hobby.
- Devon Tea and recital, showcasing, among other musicians, our own Kathy and Daryl Kemerer.
- Short afternoon tour to a tasty supper in an idyllic rural setting.

Sunday, August 14th

- Tour to Midland, located on the shore of Georgian Bay.
- Stops at a restored French fort, a spectacular Catholic Church, and a remarkably preserved Great Lakes cruise ship.

Monday, August 15th

- A fairly short local tour with a mid-afternoon return to Orillia’s wonderful Couchiching Park for rides in antique boats and Tudhope cars, followed by a final barbecue banquet. You’ll be back to the hotel in plenty of time to get your car buttoned up in its trailer.

There’s one more thing about Orillia and EMF’s. From 1910 to 1913, Tudhope cars, using the Everitt design, were manufactured locally, under license from the Metzger Motor Company of Detroit. It’s one more reason to make the trip to Canada for EMF 2016, an Outing in Lake Country.
